I know you are likely experiencing challenges on many levels - business, family, and personal. On behalf of our entire community, I want to extend the utmost expression of concern and care to you during this unprecedented time.

At this moment all childcare centers not operating with a waiver from the state are mandated to be closed by Governor Wolf. We are able to pay our staff in full through the end of April even though we have lost 93.5% of our monthly income. This is why **[we need your support.](#)**

You continue to be a critical part of our community, helping sustain our capacity to meet our mission: **Saint Mary's Nursery School is dedicated to the development of young children and to cultivating meaningful relationships with our community.** During these closure days, our staff have been making videos to share with families. As you may know, as a part of this closure, we have also cancelled our April 18th fundraiser, *Spring For Our School*.
